Effective Jan 1st, 2022

## OSP Police Judo, 5487 Lane St, Burnaby, BC:

- Proof of vaccines <u>are</u> required for youth aged 12 and up for OSP Police Judo practices taking place at 5487 Lane St., Burnaby BC
- Vaccine Card and/or proof of vaccination <u>is</u> required for instructors and coaches practicing or teaching at OSP Police Judo unless there is proof of medical exemption (Vaccine Card confirmation will be entered into Zen Planner with permission of student)
- Off mat training and common areas require masks
- Masks are optional for judo training on the mat
- Mat capacity will be 25 people
- Air circulation from front and rear doors will be provided for the training floor
- Anyone feeling ill, sick, or with a cough, fever, runny nose, headache cannot not be training regardless of COVID negative tests
